Band Earnings: Your total pay within a band set by the government each year, currently between £6,240 and £50,270.

*1/54 and 1/58 build-up rates: If you are currently below your State Pension Age (SPA) you can choose to build your pension at slower rate (1/54 Flying Staff, 1/58 Ground Staff) for future service. You pay the same Scheme contributions that you would pay for the standard build-up rate (1/52 Flying Staff, 1/56 Ground Staff) but you will not pay the additional employer's National Insurance Contributions (currently 3.1% of Band Earnings, passed onto members by the Company following the launch of the government's new State Pension arrangements from April 2016).

Your completed form must be received by 31 March 2023. We will not be able to accept your form if it is received after 31 March 2023. There will be no extension to this deadline but there are usually two opportunities to change your build-up rate on 1 April or 1 October each year.

I understand that, if I am participating in SmartPension, British Airways will pay the relevant pension contributions on my behalf and will reduce my gross pay by the same amount (but not by the 3.1% of Band Earnings if you have chosen the 1/54 or 1/58 build-up rate).
