

Discretionary increase litigation – appeal to Supreme Court

Update on hearing for Trustee’s application to use Scheme assets to fund the appeal

On 11 September 2018, we resolved to continue the appeal against the Court of Appeal’s judgment in favour of British Airways plc (BA) in the APS discretionary increase litigation.

We communicated in October that the next stage in our process is to seek permission from the Court to use Scheme assets to fund the appeal and meet BA’s costs should an appeal be unsuccessful. We expect a two-day hearing for this will take place on 18 and 19 December 2018. There may then be an interval while the Judge writes up their decision before the outcome becomes public.

We will continue to keep members updated on developments as soon as we are able to do so.
